Coach's Notes

Coach Nelson introduced Jenny Rhea, who will be taking the team pictures on August 7. The Varsity players should look at <u>JennyRhea.com</u> to order the glam photos.

Each coach introduced their team:

Coach Nelson went over the highlights of the Parent and Player Handbook. Important points are:

- Players are students first, athletes second; grades at Westwood are very important. All students must maintain a 70 or higher average in all classes, but the program prefers A/B Honor Roll. Study Halls are important, especially if your child is struggling in classes.
- Players must be on time, which means 15 minutes early for everything.
- Absences from practice have consequences. .
- Let coaches know in advance if you are missing practice or a game.

Coaches use email to communicate with the players, so make sure you are getting emails.

All athletes must stay through the end of the Varsity game. Each subvarsity player will receive three academic passes that can be used during the season, but only on Tuesday night games. All players must attend the last Varsity game, Senior Night. With a written permission form, parents can take athletes home at the end of tournaments.

Our first game is Monday, athletes must wear black shoes, socks, kneepads, and spandex. JV Orange and Varsity must wear Nike spandex.

Westwood has received approval to build two Sand Volleyball Courts, which will be located behind the softball field. The Booster Club will raise the necessary funds so they can be built by the spring.

Allison explained the volunteering requirements for the regular season: each family must volunteer for three shifts during home games. These jobs include selling concessions, running the scoreboard, doing the scorebook, and libero tracking.

Teffani described the different levels of both Family Sponsorships and Corporate Sponsorships. Jennifer Korba was introduced as the Corporate Sponsorship Committee lead and requested a Freshman or Sophomore parent to help out this year for training purposes.

Allison explained the stations to visit prior to checking out. Vanessa Robinson and Kim Sladek (Varsity players) taught a scorekeeping class to the incoming parents.
